DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision by the Pool Manager and Recreation Supervisor, ensures the safety of patrons at the aquatic facility by preventing and responding to emergencies.

- 1. Maintains constant surveillance of patrons in the facility; acts immediately and appropriately to secure safety of patrons in the event of emergency.
- 2. Enforce all laws, rules & ordinances as they relate to the facility.
- 3. Provides emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services.
- 4. Always presents professional appearance and attitude and maintains a high standard of customer service.
- 5. Performs various maintenance duties as directed to maintain a clean and safe facility.
- 6. Prepares and maintains appropriate activity reports.
- 7. Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

CPR certified; Current certification as Lifeguard by a recognized source of training, or proof of in progress certification training.

- Knowledge of and the ability to demonstrate skills to assist with swim lessons instruction.
- Ability to work independently and possess energy and enthusiasm
- Lifeguarding certification required
